This \$1,000 scholarship opportunity is open to all Worcester County public high school seniors who plan to attend a college or university within two years following graduation. Funds will be sent to the financial aid office of the school at which the student enrolls and can be applied to tuition, room, board, books, fees, and any other charges.

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of:

- Academic Merit (20%)
- Individual or group volunteerism (20%)

- Financial need (20%)
- Required essay (40%)

Instructions to Applicants

You must include a list of your 2023-2024 classes with the application. The official transcript should be provided and signed by your school guidance counselor. Please attach your resume, SAT/ACT scores, copy of Expected Family Contribution page(s) from your FAFSA application, and transcript from your scholarship portal. **Please note**: If FAFSA information is not available, please submit a paragraph detailing financial need.

Essay Topic

Please describe your academic and career goals and your plans to achieve them. Your essay should be no more than 1,000 words; there is no minimum length. Please use Times New Roman, 12-point font size; 1" margins; and double-spacing. The essay is designed to demonstrate your ability to write clearly and concisely and help set your application apart from others.

Applications are due by 4:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 19, 2024

Please submit the application in a sealed envelope labeled "Leister / Staley Scholarship" to your School Counselors' office.
